



Conditions for Hunting on TDS Leases

With over 700 active hunters in our club, it is imperative that we have strict guidelines to ensure everyone gets fair and above all, safe access to our hunting leases

- TO KEEP IN LINE WITH THE NEW BOOKING SYSTEM, **ALL PREVIOUSLY SUPPLIED PERMITS ARE NO LONGER VALID**
- Permits are issued on a “per hunt” basis, and are **only valid for the individual listed**.
ALL permits expire at the end of the nominated hunt dates and are renewable with each new application. This strategy requires more diligent planning by hunters.
- **Hunt application cut off times**
For Weekend Hunts
 - Bellevue Tier – **6pm Monday prior**
 - Native Tier/Mt Connection – **6pm Wednesday prior**For Mid Week Hunts
 - All locations – **6pm Wednesday prior**
- Permits for Bellevue Tier must be produced as proof of booking before keys will be issued – contact details for key collection will be provided when permit is issued – Keys will be limited to 1 key per hunt group only.
- Permits **MUST** be displayed on the dashboard of your vehicle at all times whilst onsite.
- Usage of dogs for hunting is prohibited.
- A record of all hunters, their permits, hunt dates and locations is maintained, therefore it is vital that you contact the Bookings Administrator if there are any changes to your permitted booking.
- Fees are to be paid once per calendar year before the first organised hunt via electronic funds transfer (using your name as the payment reference) or cheque via post. Fees are: \$80 for SSAA T10 members, or \$100 for SSAA members of another club.
- To ensure fairness and equality for all, there will be limited numbers permitted on blocks at any one point in time. This allows hunters the best opportunities and safety for the time that they have booked.
- Whilst the use of motorised vehicles such as ATV’s is permitted, please ensure that these are strictly only used on formed tracks or roads so that the environment is not disturbed. And be mindful of noise when others are hunting in the surrounding areas.
- **Wallaby spotlight permits will ONLY be issued outside of Deer Season.** When wallaby permits are issued, hunters **MUST** return their completed record summary (supplied with permit) within 2 days of return from their hunt.
- It is important to note that some of our lease boundaries are a little ambiguous and can follow a number of delineators. These may include roads, tracks, or fence lines. We do have signage but they can at times be stolen or vandalised. As a result, we ask that you take considerable care to be familiar with the block that you book and remain within your block.
- All hunters will be subject to the bylaws of our Club. Onsite access and activities are closely monitored, and any unauthorised access, or unsafe/illegal actions **WILL** be reported to the authorities. – **Non SSAA person(s) are NOT permitted access.**
- On all leased properties, **Shooters MUST wear high-visibility orange vest or hat.**
